## Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on 15<sup>th</sup> June 2023 I am pleased to confirm the following.

Please can you provide figures on the total number of patients who have had their operation cancelled for a second time. I would like these figures broken down by year for each of the past five years: 2022, 2021, 2020, 2019, 2018.

For context, I am looking for incidents where the surgery was cancelled for nonclinical reasons (i.e. staff shortages, equipment problems, lack of theatre capacity) and also not at the request of the patient.

- 2018 17 cancelled on the day for a second time.
- 15 cancelled on the day for a second time 2019
- 1 cancelled on the day for a second time. 2020
- 2021 8 cancelled on the day for a second time.
- 2022 8 cancelled on the day for a second time.

In addition, please can you provide the largest number of times that a single patient has had their operation cancelled for non-clinical reasons, over the past five years. Please could you name the operation in question (e.g. hip replacement), and the year that the last cancellation took place (e.g. 2022).
