Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on Wednesday 8th November 2023, I am pleased to confirm the following.

Spot Purchase Price - In Area – This is classified as the prevailing (latest 2023) daily fee <u>charged by you</u> to the ICS for providing care to an individual who is from your ICS region and is occupying a bed under an immediate requirement and is not contracted for and is made 'on the spot'.

Spot Purchase Price – Out of Area – This is classified as the prevailing (latest 2023) daily fee <u>charged by you</u> to the ICS for providing care to an individual who is an out-of-area patient from another ICS and is occupying a bed in your trust but is paid for by their home ICS, under an immediate requirement and is not contracted for and is made 'on the spot'.

Block contract – This is classified as the average amount spent per individual under a contract that you agree upon as a trust with your home ICS to provide care for an individual needing an inpatient bed for an acquired brain injury treatment in a level-3 neuro-rehab facility.

If the data is unavailable in the format requested, please provide the information in the following format.

Overall Average (in £) – The overall average cost of a patient that occupies a bed in a level-3 neuro-rehab facility.

The Trust does not get involved in any of the costings for ongoing care. Where the service is assessed as being needed the ICB have hold the contracts and would agree the spot funding as appropriate.
