Thank you for your request for information which we received on Tuesday 20th February 2024. I am pleased to confirm the following.

1. The number of patients who waited a) over 124 days (i.e. 4 months) and b) over 186 days (i.e. 6 months) between an urgent referral from their GP and starting their first treatment for cancer. Please can you provide figures for each of the past four calendar years (2023, 2022, 2021, 2020).

2. The single longest wait in days for a patient to start cancer treatment, as measured from the date of the urgent referral, in the 2023 calendar year?

316 days - complex low risk pathway needed several investigations and discussions with SMDT as non-cancer / supplementary reports – surgery and surveillance (non-harm)

3. The current longest wait in days for a patient still waiting to start their cancer treatment, as measured from the date of urgent referral.

145 Days - patient refused chemotherapy start and is currently back in review with oncologist following further scans (pt choice)
