I am pleased to confirm the following.

- 1) Please provide details of clinical service incidents caused by estates and infrastructure failure at your hospital trust in 2021/22.
- 2) For each incident, please provide a summary of the incident and the impact on services.

## 2021

8<sup>th</sup> July – 28<sup>th</sup> July 2021 - Theatre 2 failed its annual air handling verification which resulted in remedial work on the plant, this took a total of 4 weeks to resolve. This resulted in approximately 26 rescheduled elective surgery operations.

## 2022

15<sup>th</sup> August – 19<sup>th</sup> August - Theatre 2 HEPA filter damaged and required replacement, the knock-on effect was up to 10 elective surgical procedures require rescheduling.
