



## Request under Freedom of Information Act 2000

Thank you for your request for information which we received on Wednesday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2024. I am pleased to confirm the following.

1. How many people over the age of 65 were admitted to your hospital(s) as an unplanned (emergency) admission who were usually resident in a care home or a nursing home. Please break down by years and if possible whether it was a care home or a nursing home.

2. Of those people from Q1 how many safeguarding reports were made about concerns around the patient's welfare? I.e. abuse or neglect? Please breakdown by years and if possible, breakdown the type of safeguarding referral by category i.e. abuse, neglect.

2. Of those people from Q1 how many were recorded as either malnourished or dehydrated. (not necessarily their primary reason for being admitted). Please break down by years and if possible whether they were malnourished or dehydrated or both.

3. Of those people from Q2 how many were recorded as being admitted due to being malnourished or dehydrated (their primary reason for being admitted). Please break down by years and if possible whether they were malnourished or dehydrated or both.

4. Of those people from Q2 (recorded as dehydrated or malnourished) how many safeguarding concerns were made about the patient? Please break down by years.
