We are trying to establish the provision of chronic pain clinics for people with cancer related chronic pain. We would be grateful if you could pass the attached Freedom of Information request questions to the most appropriate colleagues in the Trust. The chronic pain service within Milton Keynes Hospital is run by the specialist pain service and is managed through GP and internal referrals. In conjunction with this the Palliative care Consultants run an additional service to support palliative patients which included cancer diagnosis to review their holistic needs, this includes pain management and liaison with the GP on identified prescriptions.

The oncology and Haematology team at Milton Keynes hospital will access both services to support patients who are suffering chronic pain for advice and guidance.
